The Board of Directors has approved the Interim Report on Operations as at September 30, 2024

Cembre (Euronext STAR): consolidated turnover up +1.3% in the first nine months of the year compared to the first nine months of 2023

- In the first 9 months, domestic sales were up +1.4% while sales outside Italy grew by +1.3% compared to the same period of 2023
- EBITDA of 28.9% of revenues (in the first nine months of 2023 it was 31.2%)
- As at October 31, 2024, consolidated revenues recorded growth of 3.0% compared to the first ten months of 2023
- Shareholders' Meeting convened for 16 December 2024 to amend the Articles of Association and Rules of Procedure.

Brescia, November 14, 2024 - The Board of Directors of Cembre S.p.A., company listed on the Star segment of the Italian Stock Exchange, one of the largest European manufacturers of electrical connectors and tools for their installation – chaired by its Chairman and Managing Director Giovanni Rosani, met today in Brescia, and approved the interim report on operations as at September 30, 2024.

In the first nine months of 2024, the Group reported <u>consolidated revenues from sales</u> of \triangleleft 171.3 million, up 1.3% from \triangleleft 169.0 million in the first nine months of 2023.

Domestic sales of the Group amounted to €75.0 million, up by 1.4%, while sales outside Italy amounted to €96.3 million, up 1.3%. In the first nine months of the year, a total of 43.8% of Group sales were represented by Italy (as compared with 43.8% in the first nine months of 2023), 44.4% by



the rest of Europe (46.0% in the first nine months of 2023), and the remaining 11.8% by the rest of the world (10.2% in the first nine months of 2023).

Consolidated gross operating profit (EBITDA) for the first nine months of 2024 amounted to €49.5 million, corresponding to a 28.9% margin on sales, down 6.1% from €52.7 million reported in the first nine months of 2023, representing a 31.2% margin on sales. This decrease was mainly due to the increase in the ratio of personnel costs to revenues from 24.7% to 26.8%. This higher incidence is the result of both the contractual increases applied during the period and the increase in the average number of Group employees from 865 in the first nine months of 2023 to 895 in the first nine months of 2024. It is estimated that this incidence will tend to decrease in the future as a result of a higher increase in sales revenues.

<u>Consolidated operating profit (Ebit)</u> amounted to €39.6 million, corresponding to a 23.1% margin on sales, down 8.6% from €43.3 million in the first nine months of 2023, corresponding to a 25.6% margin on sales revenue.

<u>Consolidated profit before taxes</u> amounted to €39.4 million, representing a 23.0% margin on sales, down 8.6% on the profit before taxes reported in the first nine months of 2023, amounting to €43.1 million and corresponding to a 25.5% margin on sales.

<u>Consolidated net profit for the period</u> fell by 9.3% compared to 2023 from €32.1 million, representing 19.0% of sales, to €29.1 million, representing 17.0% of sales.

The consolidated net financial position as at September 30, 2024, amounting to a negative €2.5 million, was down compared to December 31, 2023, when it amounted to a positive value of €18.2 million, also as a result of the payment of dividends of €30.2 million by the Parent Company and capital expenditure in fixed assets of €24.2 million. At September 30, 2023, the net financial position was equal to a surplus of €3.3 million.

As mentioned previously, <u>capital expenditure</u> in the period amounted to €4.2 million. In the same period of 2023 they amounted to €10.9 million. The increase in investments was mainly due to the construction of two industrial buildings at Cembre S.p.A.'s headquarters, totalling 15,000 m2, and advances paid to suppliers for the purchase of plant and machinery.

"The Cembre Group's consolidated revenues in the first nine months of 2024 amounted to €171.3 million, up 1.3% compared to the same period of last year. The month of October had a positive trend, and the Group's progressive sales in the first ten months of 2024 marked growth of 3.0% compared to the first ten months of 2023." - commented Chair Giovanni Rosani.

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Shareholders' Meeting convened to amend the Articles of Association and Rules of Procedure.

The Board of Directors of Cembre S.p.A. also resolved to convene the Ordinary and Extraordinary Shareholders' Meeting on December 16, 2024 (and on December 17 for the second convocation, if any), in order to amend the Articles of Association and the Rules of Procedure of the Shareholders' Meeting; for further information, please refer to the notice of call and the illustrative reports that will be published in accordance with the law.

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Cembre designs, manufactures and distributes electrical connectors and cable accessories. It enjoys a leadership position in Italy and significant market shares in the rest of Europe. Cembre is one of



the world's leading manufacturers of tools (mechanical, pneumatic and hydraulic) for the installation of connectors and the shearing of cables. The products it has developed for connection to the rail and for other railway applications are used by the main companies in this sector round the world.

Cembre owes its success to an insistence on innovative, high-quality products, a broad and thorough collection, and an extensive distribution network both in Italy and abroad.

Founded in Brescia in 1969, the Cembre Group is now a fully-fledged international force. Along with the parent company in Brescia it has seven subsidiaries: six trading companies (Germany, France, Spain, U.S.A., China and the Netherlands) and a manufacturing and trading subsidiary (Cembre Ltd, with registered office in Birmingham), for a total of 895 employees (data updated as at September 30, 2024). The Company has an Integrated Management System (quality, safety, environment and anti-corruption) certified by Lloyd's Register Quality Assurance for the design and production of accessories for cables, electrical connectors and tools for their installation.

Cembre has been listed on the Italian Stock Exchange since December 15, 1997, and on the STAR section since September 24, 2001.

In this press release, use is made of certain alternative performance indicators that are not envisaged in IFRS-EU accounting standards, and whose significance and content are illustrated below, in line with the ESMA/2015/1415 recommendations published on October 5, 2015:

<u>Gross Operating Result (EBITDA)</u>: defined as the difference between sales revenues and costs for materials, of services received, and the net balance of operating income and charges. It represents the profit achieved before amortisation, cash flows and taxes.

<u>Operating Result (EBIT)</u>: defined as the difference between the Gross Operating Result and the value of amortization/impairment. It represents the profit before cash flows and taxes.

<u>Net Financial Position</u>: represents the algebraic sum of cash and cash equivalents, financial receivables and current and non-current financial debt.
